Celebrate Recovery is for everyone who has "hurts, habits or hang-ups." It's a great way to meet others dealing with the same issues and a place where someone can share their struggles and victories.

GREETERS: These individuals create a warm, inviting environment as people arrive. Other greeters circulate around tables as people eat to let everyone know they are important and we are glad they are there.

FOOD TEAM: Sets up food, prepares coffee and drinks, and makes items ready for people.

USHERS: These individuals are responsible to insure the room is comfortable, receive the offering and serve the group during services with handouts.

SPONSORS: These people make themselves available to be contacted by others in recovery when they need encouragement or someone to talk with.

CLEAN UP TEAM: Responsible to clean up the food area after the small group time has ended.

People in our church are challenged to make a difference by reaching out to people and cultures different than their own.

DISASTER RELIEF: These teams are recruited and trained to be first responders in the event of local, national or international disasters. Current opportunities are on teams that serve

meals and teams that do clean up and debris removal.

ESL [English as a Second Language]: Volunteers do not need to speak a foreign language to serve in this ministry. Our classes meet on Tuesday at 7pm in the Care Center. Our approach is to work on a personal level with each student to help them get along better at work, running errands, shopping, asking for help, talking with their neighbors, etc.

FOREIGN MISSIONS: We are currently partnering with churches in Brazil and Peru. Our goal is to help these churches increase their influence in their communities as well as help them develop new and effective areas of impact. Trips are typically seven to ten days in length. There are between seven and eight trips during a given year.

MINISTRY TEAM: Identify and promote ministry opportunities. This involves recruiting volunteers, serving alongside them, and encouraging those who participate to share their experiences and become even more involved in ministry.

CONNECTION TEAM: Contact single adults who have expressed an interest in becoming involved in this ministry. This involves introducing/connecting them with

those in charge of activities, ministry, Life Groups, Forks & Friends, etc.

The Café & Bookstore Ministry provides volunteers with a warm and welcoming atmosphere.

CAFE BACKLINE TEAM: This team helps serve brewed coffee, pastries, and assisting Barista during Worship Services on Sunday and Monday nights.

COFFEE CART TEAM: This team sells brewed coffee and/or soft drinks in the Town Square on Sunday mornings.

BOOKSTORE TEAM: This team assists customers on the floor and at the registers on Sunday and Monday nights.

BOOKSTORE INVENTORY TEAM: This team helps with maintaining inventory counts and stocking shelves. You can volunteer during the week.

BOOKSTORE AUDIO TEAM: This team assists after each service in duplicating Sunday's messages onto CD and cassettes.

WORSHIP SERVICE FOOD TEAM: This team assists the Worship Band/Singers and Tech Team during all Sunday Worship Services by providing refreshments from the Cafe.

SPECIAL EVENTS TEAM: This team helps in the Cafe & Bookstore before, during and after any concerts, conferences, or special events.

CAFÉ & BOOKSTORE CUSTOMER SERVICE TEAM: Welcomes guests at the door with a warm smile and assists them with general information. This team is for weekend services only.

BOOKSTORE VISUAL MERCHANDISING

TEAM: Maintain all displays in the following areas: Bibles, books, music, greeting cards, etc. This team can volunteer Monday through Friday.

BOOKSTORE INVENTORY OPERATIONS

TEAM: Helps with incoming inventory. Scanning products into our system and stocking the shelves on the floor. This team can volunteer Monday - Friday.

Our mission is to reach students in all walks of life, make disciples through purposeful relationships, and train students to become leaders!

LIFE GROUP LEADER: Our Life Group Leaders are truly changing tomorrow... today! It is an incredible adventure! The challenge is enormous, but the impact is immeasurable.

FOOD SERVICE: Each Sunday night, we serve about 150 students dinner. Each week the food team decides what the students will have for dinner. They will put out the meal while the students are in Life Groups. Students eat about 7:30pm.

PARKING LOT LEADER: With more and more students getting plugged in on Sunday nights, there is a greater need to make sure that students feel welcome and safe. The Parking Lot Leader position consists of a team of parents who pick a Sunday night to help welcome students and make sure that the parking lot is safe.

THE WELCOME TEAM: When students arrive on Sunday nights, new students are encouraged to fill out a student profile sheet. Afterwards those students receive a gift bag full of gifts and information. The main point of the Welcome Team is to make the time one of the most comfortable experiences of the night and make sure that no new student feels unwelcome!

PASTORAL CARE MINISTRY

The Pastoral Care Team provides care to people of Rock Creek and their families when they are sick, homebound,

hospitalized, having surgery, bringing a new baby into the world, or grieving the death of a family member. We extend God's love and compassion into homes, hospitals, and nursing homes by sharing the hope of Christ and praying for comfort and healing.

CARE GIVER (Home): This person will be trained to develop a caring relationship with an assigned homebound person and report to the Pastoral Care Minister any basic needs of food, clothing, housing, or medical attention. The Home Care Giver will provide compassionate friendship and spiritual encouragement through weekly visits and daily calls or emails.

CARE GIVER (Hospital): This person will be trained to make assigned hospital visits to those who are sick, undergoing tests, having surgery, or bringing a new baby into the world. The Hospital Care Giver will display compassion and offer spiritual encouragement to the patient and their family members.

CARE GIVER (Nursing Home): This person will be trained to develop a caring relationship with an assigned nursing home patient and report to the Pastoral Care Minister any basic needs of clothing or medical attention. The Nursing Home Care Giver will provide compassionate friendship and spiritual encouragement through weekly visits and daily calls or emails.

CARE GIVER SITTER (Home or Hospital): Help by sitting with a patient while the primary care giver, normally a relative, takes a break to rest or tend to personal business.

HOSPICE TEAM: Each person on this team will be assigned a hospice patient to minister on a weekly basis (or when needed).

CANCER TEAM: Each volunteer on this team will be assigned a cancer patient to contact weekly. The volunteer is to encourage and minister to their spiritual needs.

CARD TEAM: Volunteers will help write greeting cards to express the hope found in Christ to Rock Creek members and/or their families during times of illness and grief.

TELEPHONE TEAM: A phone call that says we are praying for them. Volunteers will

make initial calls and/or follow up calls to help determine how the Pastoral Care Ministry can effectively express the hope found in Christ.

IN-TOUCH MINISTRY

The In-Touch Ministry supports the Pastoral Care Ministry by providing meals for the people of Rock Creek and their families during celebration of a new baby or in times of serious illness, surgery, and death. We extend God's love and compassion into homes and nursing homes by sharing the hope of Christ and praying for comfort and healing.

MEAL PREPARATION (for families grieving the death of a loved one): On short notice, help with a meal for families of 5 to 50 people. You will be volunteering to prepare a main dish, vegetable, dessert, drinks or paper goods.

MEAL PREPARATION (homebound and long term illnesses): Help with meals that are prepared as needed for the family of someone who is seriously ill, homebound or taking a new baby home from the hospital.

MEAL DELIVERY (In -Touch Meals): On short notice, you will display friendliness and compassion as you deliver meals to an individual or family, when a new baby goes home from the hospital, or in times of serious illness, surgery, or death.

MEAL SERVERS: Serve, setup and clean up on short notice, before or after a funeral, for the family of the deceased.

The Music & Worship Ministry exists to provide a worship experience that will communicate hope to the unchurched and encourage believers in their personal walk of faith.

CELEBRATION CHOIR: Celebration Choir is open to all adults 18+ who love to sing. We sing at least once a month in all Worship Services. Rehearsals are on Wednesday nights.

VOCAL TEAM: This group of singers leads worship weekly in our weekend services on a rotation basis. This group requires an audition. Auditions are held at least two or three times a year.

WORSHIP BAND: This group of instrumentalists lead worship in our weekend services on a rotation basis. This group requires an audition. Auditions are held at least two or three times a year.

CELEBRATE RECOVERY: This is a group of instrumentalists and singers that provide worship music every Tuesday for Celebrate Recovery.

ROCK CREEK CARE CENTER

The Care Center Ministry provides an opportunity for individuals to serve in an environment that will encourage individuals to step out of their comfort zone and allow the Lord to use them in many ways. This center allows individuals to serve in a way that would allow those who are being served to see the love of Christ.

FOOD BANK: Help box up food items and interact with those individuals who are coming to receive food. This is a one day a week commitment for three hours.

CAREERLINK: Help assists the unemployed or underemployed with their efforts to achieve their goals in life. This is a great way to interact and encourage students to make positive decisions. This is a once a week opportunity from 9am-3pm for seven weeks.

COMPUTER LAB: Assist and teach computer skills from beginners to advance. Commitment time will vary.

TECHNICAL MINISTRY TEAM

Our Technical Ministry Team consists of individuals who volunteer each week to provide support to the many ministries of

our church. Opportunities abound for those with a gift for the technical aspects of sound, lighting, cameras, and video production.

SOUND TECHNICIAN: Responsible for the audio aspect of the Worship Service and special events. This includes the selection, setup, operation and tear-down of all audio equipment needed in a particular service or event.

LIGHTING TECHNICIAN: Responsible for the lighting aspect of the Worship Service and special events. This includes both house and theatrical lighting.

SLIDE TECHNICIAN: Responsible for the presentation media of the Worship Service and special events. This includes the use of PowerPoint slides during worship, music, and the message.

CAMERA TECHNICIAN: Responsible for visually capturing the events of the Worship Service and special events. This includes set up of camera and following cues from Service Director.

STAGE CREW: Responsible for working with Sound Technicians each week to prepare the Worship Center for the weekend services and special events.

Guest Ministry provides a friendly atmosphere by populating the parking lot, lobby, information kiosks and auditorium with warm welcoming and caring volunteers who provide the personal touch to our church. We are the eyes and hands that welcome every guest God brings through our doors and we help personalize their experience.

PARKING TEAM (Parking Lot): Help provide a warm, friendly and inviting atmosphere to all the guests who enter our campus. Help our guests by directing them to the appropriate parking space. Welcome people as they exit their cars and walk through the parking lot.

GUEST HOST (Greeters): Help provide a warm, friendly and inviting atmosphere to all guests who walk through our doors. Interact with our guests and help assist them in obtaining needed information.

SERVICE HOST (Ushers): Provide world-class service by creating a safe, inviting and Christ-like feel within our auditorium. Greet and interact with guests while helping them find seats. Help with the collection of the offering at the end of the service.

INFORMATION HOST (Information Pavilion): Help assist guests in obtaining information about various ministries, directing guests to different areas of the building, and assisting guests with enrollment in ministry sponsored activities and programs.

FIRST TIME GUEST HOST: Provide first time guests with a gift bag after each service that contains information about our church along with some good things to eat.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Children's Ministry provides a safe and creative environment for children, infants-fifth grade, to learn about Jesus and His love for them. Our adult leaders and teen helpers join together to teach the Bible creatively in order to bring God's word to a child's world.

CHECK-IN VOLUNTEER: Greet families at the Children's Check-In Kiosks 30 minutes prior to each Sunday or Monday service. Volunteer will assist the family in obtaining each child's computer generated name tag with a parent pick-up tag.

FIRST TIME VISITOR CHECK-IN (Children's Ministry Information Desk): Greet first time visiting parents and their children and make them feel welcome. Assist the families in registering their children for a class and obtaining a computer generated name tag and parent pick-up tag. Volunteer would also be available to escort families to the appropriate classrooms.

PRESCHOOL (Infant - K4): Weekly participation is required in ministering with a team of volunteers to a specific preschool age group during one of our Sunday or Monday services. Age appropriate Bible lessons help to introduce the children to God through art, music, puppetry, story time and games. It is a fun place where preschoolers learn about God's truth and His love. All workers are required to fill out

a State Police Background Check with an application.

ELEMENTARY (K5-5th grade): Adult and teen volunteers create a fun and energetic atmosphere to learn about God and His Son Jesus. Creative Bible lessons are taught in order to help elementary kids understand what it means to make Jesus their "forever friend". Each class also focuses on Bible memorization and learning the Books of the Bible. Volunteers are asked to serve weekly in one of our Sunday or Monday services. All workers are required to submit to a State Police Background Check with an application.

BREAKOUT: A four year Life Group discipleship class for children in grades 2-5. Adult leaders guide and encourage the children as they grow spiritually. Life Group

leaders are assigned to the same group of children for as long as the group attends Breakout. Leaders are needed each year as a new class begins. Breakout is a child's version of Rock Creek's Life Development Process. All workers are required to submit to a State Police Background Check with an application.

KIDZ RAP (Kidz Reaching All People): The purpose of this ministry is to bring children and their families together to serve along side each other. We provide "hands on" ministry projects that reach people who are in need in our community, church, state, nation and abroad. We meet one Saturday each month for no more than two hours. Kidz RAP needs volunteers in the following areas: computer work, crafts, phone calling, organization of activities, brainstorming ideas, host/hostess, leading

events, media/promotion, prayer, snacks, and event preparation.
